

village of Vianden. Vianden lies at the river banks of the Our, in the heart of a varied landscape. The massive castle with its ring wall and watchtowers rises over the village and is one of the most beautiful feudal residences of Europe rising above the village. Every year during the month of August, a well-attended medieval festival is organised in the castle.

(A) The youth hostel

The youth hostel is located in the upper part of the village in a traditional house located below the spectacular castle. 66 beds are disposed in 10 rooms with two to twelve beds. Showers and WC are on the respective floors. Group activities and children's birthdays are available on request. The in-house restaurant 'Melting Pot' serves menus and fresh and regional specialties on a daily basis upon reservation. Guests of all ages wanting to discover the charming village are welcome here at the youth hostel.

Leisure

The valley of the Our is the perfect place to discover nature on foot or by mountain bike. If you're more into history, why not visit the impressive castle. The Victor Hugo museum relates the life of the writer and explains why he fell under the spell of this village. A ride on the chairlift will let you discover Vianden from a different perspective. During summer, the open air swimming pool welcomes its guests. If you've always been interested in science, why not visit the largest pumped-storage power plant in Europe and find out all about electricity. In the neighbouring village of Stolzembourg, you can discover the retrieval of copper ore in a mine located 50 metre under the earth. More information about the activities:

• Getting there

Vianden is located at the border of Germany, 48 km from Luxemburg-City. The village can easily be reached by public transportation from Ettelbruck and Clervaux. The bus station 'Vianden, Bréck' is situated in the middle of the village, only a 10 minutes' walk to the youth hostel. The following bus lines also stop here: 570 (Ettelbruck-Diekirch-Vianden-Stolzembourg), 571 (Ettelbruck, Vianden, Stolzembourg), 572 (Vianden-Scheierhaff), 663 (Clervaux-Vianden), 664 (Vianden-Hosingen-Clervaux) and 842 (Dasbourg/Pont-Colmar-Usines).
