The MS RheinDream – modern, elegant, and comfortable The MS RheinDream was inaugurated in 2011 and is the newest ship in the Rössler Line fleet. Its name says it all: equipped with 530 hp and state-of-the-art safety standards, it glides smoothly and stylishly across the water.

Cuisine & atmosphere on board

Look forward to a hearty winegrower's snack with sausage, ham, cheese, bread, butter, and potato salad—served on one of the two inner decks.

Drinks included: On board, you can enjoy selected wines from Rheingau and Rudesheim winemakers. Also included in the price are beer (pilsner and wheat beer) and a selection of non-alcoholic beverages.



Music & atmosphere: A DJ will provide the party atmosphere – weather permitting, the celebration will take place outdoors on the open deck.

Boarding & disembarking

The ship is scheduled to dock at pier no. 16 in Rudesheim at 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, July 3, 2027, for boarding. Disembarkation in Rudesheim will take place around midnight. Alternatively, you can board at around 7:30 p.m. at pier no. 6 (Rössler Steiger) in Assmannshausen. Disembarkation in Assmannshausen is then scheduled for around 1:00 a.m. Please be at the respective pier in good time before departure – the ship cannot wait if you are late.

👉 **Important:** Shortly before the event, you will receive a message with the exact start time and, if applicable, a different bridge.

Itinerary & fireworks convoy

After casting off, the MS RheinDream sets off on an atmospheric journey through the romantic Upper Middle Rhine Valley, which has been a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 2002.

At around 10 p.m., the ship meets the other participants in the festive convoy at Trechtingshausen. As darkness falls over the valley, the fleet sets off—past castles illuminated by Bengal lights and a series of impressive fireworks displays along the Rhine. An unforgettable experience against a historic backdrop.

The event ends around midnight with the return to Rüdesheim.
