Rüdesheim am Rhein (scheduled for 5:00 p.m.) Return: 12:00 a.m.
- **Itinerary:**  
After setting sail, we head downstream into the romantic Upper Middle Rhine Valley, a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 2002. Enjoy the impressive Rhine landscape while indulging in culinary delights on board. DJ & Party on the outdoor deck – celebrate under the open sky

## City map (excerpt) showing the bridges in Rudesheim am Rhein



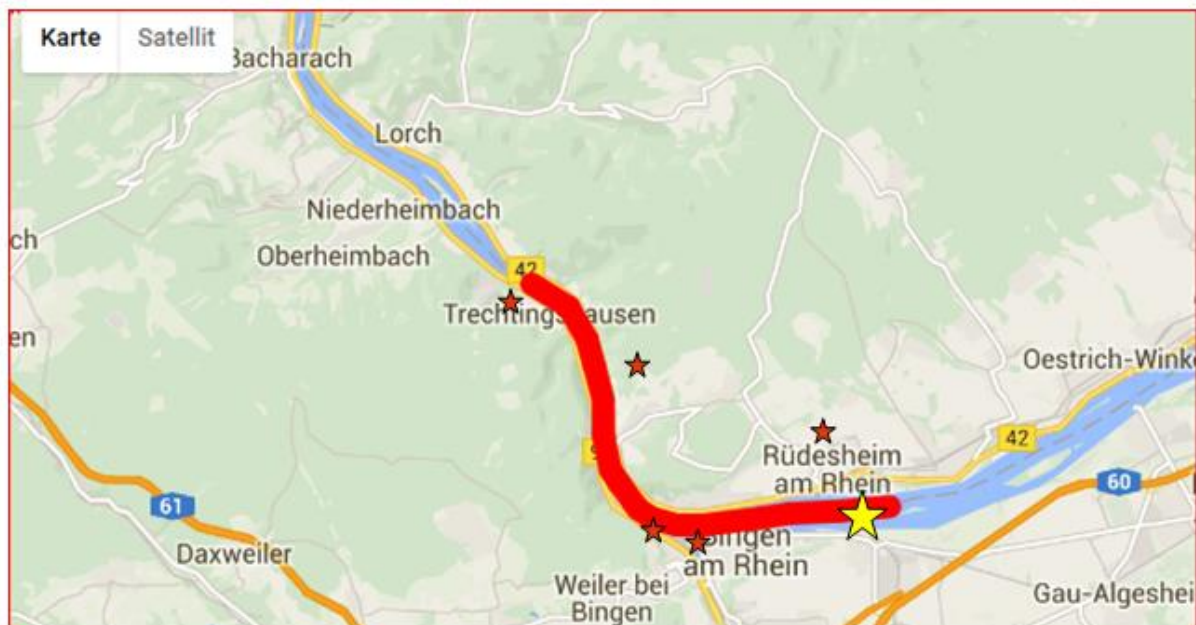
### Parking in Rudesheim

- **Free parking lots:**  
Currently, parking lots P7 and P5 are available free of charge. However, they fill up quickly – early arrival is recommended.
- **Municipal parking areas:**  
Most city parking spaces are subject to charges between 9:00 am and 6:00 pm.
- **Private parking lots:**  
Individual regulations apply – please check directly with the respective providers.

*Note: Please plan enough time for parking. Rudesheim is very busy during "Rhine in Flames," and parking availability is limited.*
