Important Information (Please read before starting)

-  Required Documentation: It is essential to present your original ID card or passport. Monument staff will not allow access without physical identification.

-  Meeting Point: Main entrance of the Alcazaba (Calle Almanzor). Please be punctual.

-  Clothing and Weather: Comfortable/sports shoes are essential. As this is an outdoor tour, we recommend bringing water, a hat, and sunscreen.

-  Accessibility and Health Warning: The Alcazaba is a medieval fortress with steep stairs, ramps, and uneven floors.

- No accessibility: The site does not have elevators or escalators.
 - Health restrictions: People with reduced mobility or serious respiratory/coronary problems are advised against participating due to the physical exertion required.
